	Several of the interior LED light pucks have been replaced. When one starts to flicker we generally replaced it and added easy wire connections to ease any further replacements. They are hardwired originally. There are a couple of spares on board that already have the connections added but on replacing the original ones connectors will have to be added if one wants to continue that process (other wise one can just cut and splice). The connectors are just standard insulated 12V spade connectors.
